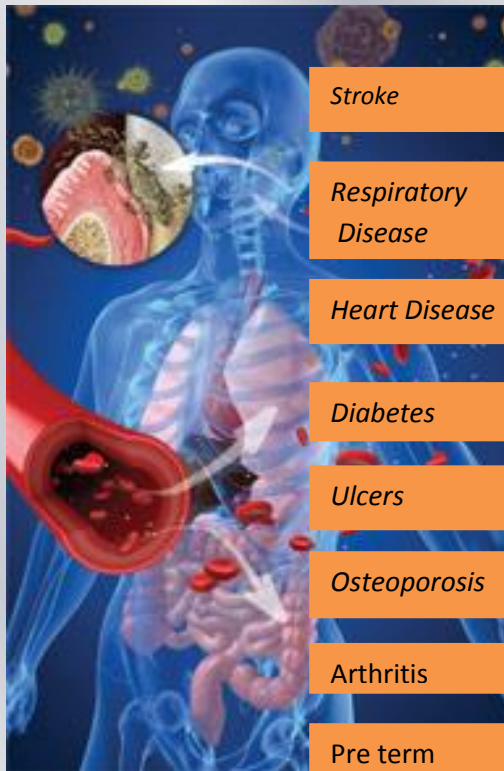

Patients with periodontal disease are **3 times** more likely to suffer a heart attack or stroke.

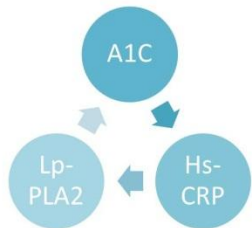
Do you have diabetes?	Y	N

By checking inflammation markers, your provider can give you a picture of where you are on the spectrum of risk.

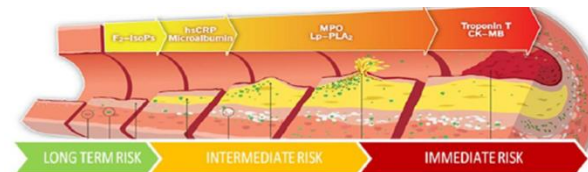


The Heart Smart Screen ® is a finger-stick test done in the dental office.

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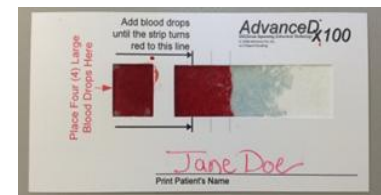
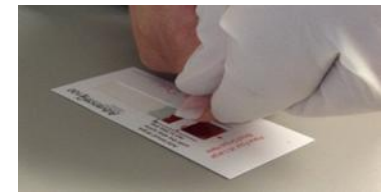
Why is this test panel important to me?

How is the test administered?

About 5 drops of blood is needed and is collected via finger-stick and stored and shipped on a patented dry blood spot card.
